Requirements for the NSF Computer Science, Engineering and Mathematical Sciences Scholarships

1. United States citizens, nationals, refugee aliens, or permanent resident aliens.
2. Be a major in Computer Science, Engineering or Mathematics (includes the B.S. in Science-Mathematics Track) discipline.
3. Have demonstrated financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid under U.S. Department of Education guidelines.
4. Must be able to attend full time if awarded scholarship.
5. Have an overall GPA of 2.7.
6. Submit a recommendation letter from Computer Science, Engineering or Mathematics instructor.
7. Submit a personal statement indicating career goals, progress toward degree and containing a commitment to attend full-time and complete degree within the allotted time.
8. Submit a Financial Aid “Need for Scholarship Consideration” form with your application. The committee will send this form to the financial aid office for completion.
9. Agree to complete an Individualized Contract. The adherence to this contract will be a requirement to initially receive and then to continue to receive the scholarship. As a part of this contract the scholar will agree to various activities including: maintenance of full-time status, participation in regular meetings with CSEM advisor and academic advisor, attendance at Career Day, etc.
9. You may be eligible for continued support from this scholarship, but you are required to reapply for it each year.
